
SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES Available at the **BEGINNING OF EACH FALL SEMESTER**



- 1. Academic Excellence Scholarship -- Minimum cumulative GPA 78% and must be a KCCL student having completed at least two full semesters of study. **\$2,000.00**
- Overall Scholarship Minimum cumulative GPA 75% and must be a KCCL student having completed at least two full semesters of study.
 \$1,500.00
- Veteran/First Responder Minimum cumulative GPA 72% and must be a KCCL student having completed at least two full semesters of study. \$1,500.00

*U.S. MILITARY: must have been honorably discharged from U.S. military services or in reserve service.

*FIRST RESPONDER: must have had one year or more as a first responder before or during law school. <u>First responders are police officers</u>, firefighters, paramedics.

Kern County College of Law offers three (3) separate scholarships for each school year. Scholarship applications are due by <u>MIDNIGHT, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29th</u>. Your application must be submitted to the Campus Administrator, Bobbie Hernandez (<u>bhernandez@kerncountylaw.org</u>) on or before that date. Late applications will not be considered.

The applications will be reviewed by a committee which will include one Kern County College of Law professor, a member of the Monterey College of Law administration, and a member from the Kern County Bar Association.

All decisions by the committee will be final. Students may apply for as many scholarships for which they meet the minimum qualifications. A separate application form must be submitted for each scholarship, and no student may be awarded more than one scholarship. The application can be found on the KCCL website and NO FINANCIAL INFORMATION IS REQUIRED.
